The United States District Court for the Western District of Texas is currently accepting applications for the position of Official Court Reporter in its Del Rio Division. Real time experience and/or certification is preferred but not a requirement. Applicants must possess at least four years prime court reporting experience in other courts, the freelance field, or a combination thereof. Additionally, applicants must own or be willing to purchase, upon entry on duty, court reporting equipment. Applicants must be qualified for listing on the registry of the National Shorthand Reporters Association, or have passed an equivalent qualifying examination. Salary range is \$62,563 to \$71,947 annually, depending on qualifications, plus transcript fees, established by the Judicial Conference. Successful candidate must be available for overnight travel and must be willing to substitute for other staff court reporters as needed.
