ORDER

On this day, the Court considered Defendant Jose Alonso Compean's "Motion to Continue Bond Pending Appeal." The Court has considered the Motion and the government's Response and is of the opinion that the Motion (Doc. No. 194) should be **DENIED**.

Because Defendant has been convicted of a crime of violence, he is eligible for release pending appeal only for "exceptional reasons" pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3145. The Court finds that no "exceptional reasons" exist in this case. Accordingly, the Court's previous Order is **ADHERED TO**. Defendant Compean is hereby **ORDERED** to voluntarily surrender to his designated Federal Correctional Institution or the United States Marshal by 2:00 p.m. on January 17, 2007.
