ORDER REGARDING ENTRY INTO COURTHOUSE

To protect public health and in recognition of the national emergency that was declared by the President of the United States on March 13, 2020, the United States District Court for the Western District of Texas, San Antonio Division, hereby issues the following order:

The John H. Wood, Jr. United States Courthouse, 655 E. Cesar E. Chavez Blvd. and Court Agencies at 727 E. Cesar E. Chavez Blvd., San Antonio, Texas, will be open for business to the public, but access to the building will be restricted under the following terms and conditions.


The Court's Order filed October 26, 2020, is withdrawn, and the following is substituted in its place.

IT IS ORDERED that individuals who are fully vaccinated may enter the facility without a mask. The wearing of an appropriate mask THAT COVERS THE PERSON'S NOSE, AND MOUTH is still required for individuals not fully vaccinated. Any Individual may choose to wear a mask and physically distance at any time, regardless of vaccination status.

All individuals authorized to enter must abide by social distancing protocols and instructions directed by Court Security.
