**FIFTEENTH ORDER RELATING TO ENTRY INTO  
THE UNITED STATES COURTHOUSE AUSTIN, TEXAS**

To protect public health and in recognition of the national emergency that was declared by the President of the United States on March 13, 2020, the United States District Court for the Western District of Texas, Austin Division, hereby renders the following order:

The United States Courthouse, 501 W. 5th Street, Austin, Texas, will be open for business to the public, but access to the building will be restricted under the following terms and conditions:

**IT IS ORDERED** that individuals who are fully vaccinated may enter the facility without a mask. The wearing of an appropriate mask **THAT COVERS THE PERSON’S NOSE AND MOUTH** is required for individuals not fully vaccinated. An individual may choose to wear a mask and physically distance at any time, regardless of vaccination status.


All individuals authorized to enter must abide by social distancing protocols and instructions as directed by Court Security.

This order supersedes all previous orders relating to entry into the United States Courthouse.
