STANDING ORDER

In accordance with the authority vested in the United States Magistrate Judge pursuant to Rule 1 of the Local Rules for the Assignment of Duties to United States Magistrate Judges, Appendix C of the Local Court Rules of the United States District Court for the Western District of Texas, it is hereby **ORDERED** that all cases seeking judicial review under 42 USC § 405(g) or § 1383(c)(3) of decisions by the Social Security Administration shall be referred to a Magistrate Judge for the San Antonio Division for disposition of all non-dispositive pretrial matters as provided in 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(A), and for findings and recommendations on all case-dispositive motions as provided in 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B).
