



FORFEITURE ENFORCEMENT**



P. 46, the Government shall do so by commencing a new civil action, including a civil cover sheet with the criminal case number as a related case. The Government shall include all documents related to the bond revocation and bail forfeiture as attachments.

IT IS SO ORDERED.


