## AMENDED STANDING ORDER REGARDING JOINT OR UNOPPOSED REQUEST TO CHANGE DEADLINES

Extensions for final submission deadlines at least one month before a scheduled hearing, trial, or Court event will not affect the Court. The parties are **ORDERED** to file any such request as a notice or stipulation to the Court, instead of a motion.
