AMENDED ORDER REGARDING CELL PHONES AND OTHER ELECTRONIC DEVICES

Only attorneys and individuals who are parties to the litigation may bring cell phones, smartwatches, laptops, tablets, or other electronic devices with audio and visual recording capabilities into the United States Courthouse, 800 Franklin, Waco, Texas. The use of smartwatches, laptops, tablets, cameras, or other electronic devices with audio or visual recording capabilities are strictly prohibited, unless previously authorized by the court. For security reasons, all individuals may be asked to demonstrate to a Court Security Officer or Deputy United States Marshal that their electronic device(s) work as intended.

The photographing, recording, broadcasting or televising of any person, object, or proceeding inside the United States Courthouse is not permitted, unless previously authorized by the court. The United States Marshal Service and the Court Security Officers shall be extra vigilant in ensuring that cellular telephones, laptops, and tablets with camera capabilities, cameras, smartwatches, or other recording devices are not used to photograph, record, broadcast, or televise any person, object or proceeding. Any individual who violates this Order may be subject to being removed from the United States Courthouse and having his or her electronic device(s) forfeited to the United States Marshal Service.

All electronic devices must be put on silent mode while inside any courtroom and no conversation may take place using any device without leave of court.

Electronic devices may be used outside of the courtrooms if they are used in a reasonable and nondisruptive manner.
