ORDER

At the request of various court agencies, came on this date to be considered the matter of multiple Motions for Continuance of the Rearraignment proceeding in criminal matters. Effective September 3, 2019 and remaining in effect until further Order of the Court, the Court will grant one (1) Motion for Continuance of the Rearraignment hearing as a matter of course. Any and all subsequent Motions for Continuance of the Rearraignment hearing filed in the Waco division of the United States District Court for the Western District of Texas must include a Certificate of Conference stating that all parties have conferred. The Certificate of Conference will state each party's position regarding the motion. It is unacceptable for Movant to state in the Motion that Movant has attempted to confer with the Government, but the Government was not available at the time of attempted conference. Additionally, the title of the Motion must identify whether the Motion is Opposed or Unopposed and identify the number of continuances previously filed (e.g., "Defendant's Second Unopposed Motion for Continuance"). Failure to comply with this Order will result in the summary denial of Movant's Motion. A summary denial of the Motion by the Court will include a copy of this Order as a reminder to counsel.
