## STANDING ORDER FOR DISCOVERY HEARINGS IN PATENT CASES

If there is a dispute as to the language of the order, the parties shall submit their respective proposed orders to the Court for resolution. Additional time for submission or other relief from this Order will only be granted with a showing of good cause.
