STANDING ORDER REGARDING
JOINT OR UNOPPOSED REQUEST TO CHANGE DEADLINES

In all cases pending before the undersigned, henceforth, the Court automatically grants any request to extend a deadline (except as to the deadline to answer or otherwise respond to a complaint) or to amend a scheduling order, provided that (1) such request is unopposed or agreed to between the parties, (2) such request does not change the date of any hearing, trial, or other Court date, and (3) such request does not extend any deadline of a final submission that affects the Court's ability to hold a scheduled hearing, trial, or Court event. Extensions for final submission deadlines at least one month before a scheduled hearing, trial, or Court event will not affect the Court. The parties are **ORDERED** to file any such request as a notice or stipulation to the Court, instead of a motion.

This Order amends and supersedes the Court's previous Standing Order Regarding Joint or Unopposed Request to Change Deadlines dated February 13, 2025.
