## What is CM/ECF?

- ☐ CM Case Management System
  - Manages the court docket, images and noticing.
- ECF Electronic Case Files
  - Allows registered users to file electronically with the court
  - Electronic Case files and documents available on PACER.

## E-Filings

- All civil, criminal, miscellaneous, magistrate and sealed cases are assigned to the Electronic Filing System.
- All electronically filed documents must be submitted in portable document format (PDF).
- ☐ The clerk's office no longer maintains a paper case file with the exception of prisoner cases and some sealed cases.


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


## E-Filings

- The electronic case file is the official record of the court.
- Public access PCs are available in each divisional office.











## Proofread before you file it

There is a danger in recycling similar documents. Make sure the document you are filing says exactly what you meant it to say.







## Use "free looks" in PACER to create e-files of your cases

- When you receive a notice of electronic filing (NEF) evidencing a document or order that's been filed in your case, you get a "free look" at the filed document.
- □ Save these e-documents in a case file you create in your computer system. Having your own e-files avoids piling up PACER fees and saves copy and filing expenses for your firm.



## Top Ten E-Filing Errors

- 1. No signature on main document and certificate of service.
- 2. Not including a proposed order with a motion that requires a proposed order.
- 3. No certificate of service or incomplete certificate of service.
- 4. Choosing the incorrect event.



## Top Ten E-Filing Errors

- 5. Filing a pleading that has more than one event and selecting only one event from the cm/ecf system when filing the pleading.
- 6. Filing pleadings that should be traditionally filed.
- 7. Filing a pleading that has one part of it sealed and attempting to e-file the entire pleading.

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## Top Ten E-Filing Errors

- 8. Filing a motion for "Leave to File" and docketing the attached document.
- 9. Linking yourself with the opposing party or to a party you do not represent.
- 10. Not selecting all filers when submitting a joint filing.

#### **Administrative Policies and Procedures for Electronic Filing in Civil and Criminal Cases**

#### Can now be filed electronically:

- Complaints and Notice of Removal
- Answers
- Amended Complaints
- Consents and Non-Consents to proceed before a Magistrate Judge
- Sealed documents filed in unsealed cases
- Ex Parte documents filed in unsealed cases



## Traditionally Filed Documents

The following documents must be submitted traditionally:

Pleadings which add parties or assert new claims	Notices of appeal
Motions to Intervene	Refusal of Magistrate Jurisdiction
Motions to proceed IFP	Waivers
Amicus motions	Writs
Transcript orders	Financial affidavits
Trial exhibits	Vouchers for CJA payment



#### Plea Agreements

- Shall be filed electronically
- NEF generated to all parties
- Electronic access is limited to court users
- Document available to the public at Clerk's Office
- Defendant's signature must be in a scanned format

#### Sealed Plea Agreements

- Shall be filed electronically
- NEF will be generated to the Government and applicable defendant only
- Defendant's signature must be in a scanned format



#### **Sealed Documents**

- May be filed electronically.
- Cannot be accessed by attorneys and public.
- NEF will be generated, but document will not be viewable.
- Parties must perform service.

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# Amended Privacy Policy and Public Access to Electronic Files (filed October 29, 2004)


The following personal information should be excluded from documents filed with the Court or redacted unless otherwise ordered by the Court:

- □ Social Security number. (limit to last four digits)
- Names of minor children. (use initials only)
- ☐ Dates of birth. (limit to year of birth only)
- ☐ Financial account numbers. (limit to last four digits)
- ☐ Home addresses in criminal case. (limit to city & state)




## **Redaction Message**


The Committee on Court Administration and Case Management issued a new requirement to modify the redaction disclaimer text on the login screen, add hyperlinks to the rules, and add a checkbox to the login screen for attorneys. Attorney users and pro se litigants must check this new checkbox to acknowledge having read the redaction disclaimer. In addition, the reminder question *Have you redacted?* was added to the final text review screen during docketing. All filers (including court users) logged in via the outside server will see this message.





#### Privacy Policy

In accordance with the E-Government Act of 2002, and in order to promote electronic access to case files while also protecting personal privacy, rules providing protection for case file records took effect on December 1, 2007.

Parties should either exclude sensitive information in any documents filed with the court, or partially redact such sensitive information where inclusion is necessary and relevant to the case. All filers are encouraged to reference the <a href="Amended Privacy Policy and Public Access to Electronic Files">Amended Privacy Policy and Public Access to Electronic Files</a>, which details the rules of this court regarding redaction of personal identifiers.

Please note that you may e-file at any time, but CM/ECF support (ECF Support Desk) is only offered Monday through Friday, 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. CST, excluding court holdays. No after hours support is available. When relevant, please include the Case Number and the Judge's initials in the Subject: line of all emails to the court.

All admitted attorneys are required to register to file electronically and are required to update their email addresses, making address, and phone number online by logging into CM/ECF. In order to receive your Notices of Electronic Filing on your cases, you must ensure that your email addresses are up-to-date at all times.

Attomeys and other recipients the attorney has designated to receive e-mail notices are sent e-mail using the bcc (bind carbon copy) address field. The e-mail will be addressed to "CMECF\_NOTICES@TXWD.USCOURTS.GOV" and the e-mail will be from "TXW\_USDC\_NOTICE@TXWD.USCOURTS.GOV". Attorneys must ensure these addresses are not blocked or marked as span. Attorneys are also responsible for ensuring their e-mail box does not become full and cause e-mail notices to
