STANDING ORDER

In accordance with the authority vested in the United States Magistrate Judge pursuant to Rule 1 of the Local Rules for Assignment of Duties to United States Magistrate Judges, Appendix C of the Local Court Rules of the United States District Court for the Western District of Texas, it is hereby **ORDERED** that all cases seeking judicial review under Title 42 United States Code section 405(g) or section 1383(c)(3) of decisions by the Social Security Administration shall be referred to a Magistrate Judge for the Austin Division for disposition of all non-dispositive pretrial matters as provided in Title 28 United States Code section 636(b)(1)(A), and for findings and recommendations on all case-dispositive motions as provided in Title 28 United States Code section 636(b)(1)(B). This Standing Order supersedes all previous standing orders entered in this division regarding judicial review of decisions by the Social Security Administration.
