**STANDING ORDER FOR
DISCOVERY HEARINGS IN PATENT CASES**

The prevailing party in all future discovery hearings shall submit a proposed order to the Court that briefly summarizes the nature of the dispute along with the parties' understanding of the Court's ruling. A proposed order, agreed to by both sides, shall be submitted to the Court no later than seven (7) days after the conclusion of the discovery hearing. If there is a dispute as to the language of the order, the parties shall submit their respective proposed orders to the Court for resolution. Additional time for submission or other relief from this Order will only be granted with a showing of good cause.
