

ORDER REGARDING CELL PHONES AND ELECTRONIC DEVICES

Only attorneys and individuals who are parties to the litigation may bring cell phones into the United States Courthouse, 800 Franklin, Waco, Texas. For security reasons, however, all individuals may be asked to demonstrate his or her cellular telephone to a Court Security Officer or Deputy United States Marshal that the device works as intended.

The photographing, recording, broadcasting or televising or any person, object or proceeding inside the United States Courthouse is not permitted, unless previously authorized by the court. The United States Marshals Service and the Court Security Officers shall be extra vigilant in ensuring that cellular telephones with camera capabilities, cameras, or other recording devices are not used to photograph, record, broadcast, or televise any person, object or proceeding. Any individual who violates this Order may be subject to being removed from the United States Courthouse and having his or her electronic device forfeited to the United States Marshals Service.

Cellular telephones must be put on silent mode while inside any courtroom and no conversation may take place using any cell phone without leave of court.

Cellular telephones may be used outside of the courtrooms provided that they are used in a reasonable and nondisruptive manner.
